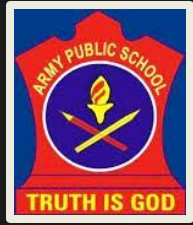

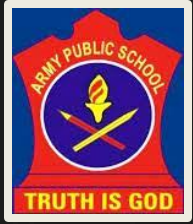
GRADE : III to V

GRADE : VI to VIII

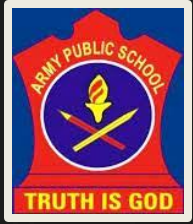

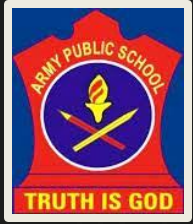
GRADE : IX to X
