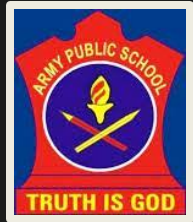

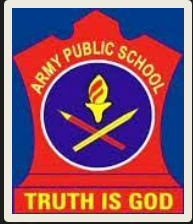
GRADE : III to V

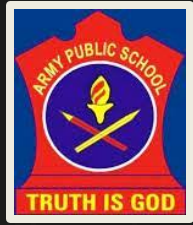
GRADE : V to VIII

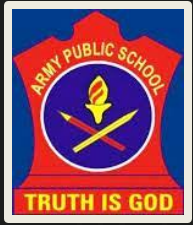
GRADE : IX to X
